▼ Self Hired Respite Programs

The Arc's Self Hired Respite programs are designed to provide respite services to families who wish to recruit and hire their respite worker of choice. Based upon a referral from the Department of Children and Families (DCF) via Perform Care, families of children under age 21 will be allocated a number of hours of service per 90 day period. Once the respite has occurred, The Arc will reimburse the cost of the respite up to the numbers of hours allotted at the rate designated by DCF.
