



ALTERNATIVES TO DOMESTIC VIOLENCE YOUTH EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM

ADV's Youth Empowerment Programs (YEP) are gender-inclusive safe spaces for teens and young adults to explore the contexts of power in their lives, to promote healing from harmful experiences of abuse, and to practice positive support-seeking practices.

SERVICES

- <u>Healthy Relationships for Teens (HRTs)</u> <u>Groups</u>: Teens will explore how to have healthy relationships with self, peers, and loved ones and to safely disrupt abuse in their environments. Groups meet weekly with several weekday and virtual/in-person options.
 HRT Group for youth identifying as LGBTQIAP+ also available.
- <u>Healthy Relationship Consultations</u>: free, educational, one-time sessions for individuals or small groups who are looking for clarity or constructive feedback about their relationships.
- Individual Counseling for Teens:
 on a case by case basis

ELIGIBILITY

- Any youth ages 14-21 in Bergen County that is concerned about the health of their intimate relationships.
- Teens ages 14-15 must be registered by their legal guardian.
- Teens ages 16+ can register by themselves.
