The Rainbow Summer Day Program, also known as Camp Rainbow, has been in continuous operation since 1950 when it was the first summer camp for children with disabilities in the United States

PROGRAM:

Six (6) Weeks of operation: July and August

Time: Monday to Friday from 9:00am - 3:00pm

<u>Transportation</u>: Door to door transportation is provided daily.

Participants: Children (age 6 through 21) and adults with developmental disabilities.

Schedule:

Participants arrive at the program at 9:00am. In a mixture of large and small groups, Campers participate in varied activities (music, art, gym, dance, swimming etc.) and special events in the community.

<u>Staff:</u> The program has a Director & Assistant Director, nurse, licensed special education teachers, instructors, counselors and paraprofessional counselors.

The program also serves as an extended school year program for many local schools and a respite program for many families who would otherwise have no childcare during the summer months.
